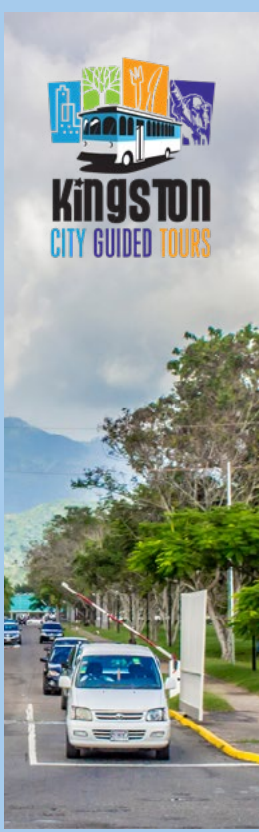

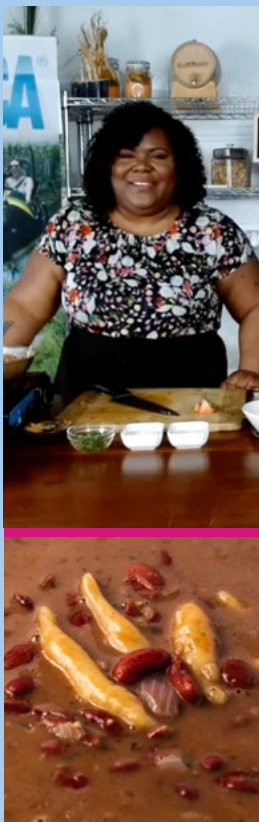

MAJOR REDEVELOPMENT UNDERWAY AT SANGSTER INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Montego Bay’s Sangster International Airport (MBJ) has begun an extensive redevelopment project, which will see major changes to the vehicular exit and entrance to the airport. When completed, the roundabout will be widened and become a dual-lane thoroughfare in both directions. Further work will include expanding the public car park and realigning the roadway, creating a separate loop for departure and arrival traffic. As part of this landside development project, the Texaco gas station is no longer at the airport.

Work is expected to be completed by November 30, 2023, while the airport maintains normal operations during construction.

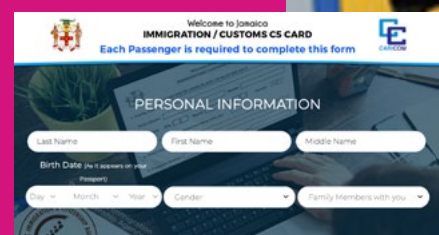

SUBMIT YOUR JAMAICA IMMIGRATION ENTRY CARD ONLINE!

Visitors to Jamaica have the option to submit an online immigration card, prior to arrival on island. The card may be submitted even a week before travel. Upon arrival in Jamaica, proceed to the designated immigration line and let the officer know you filled out the C-5 entry card online. Your submitted information will be displayed on the screen once the officer inputs your passport number. Your airline will continue to issue the paper card on the airplane if you prefer that option.
